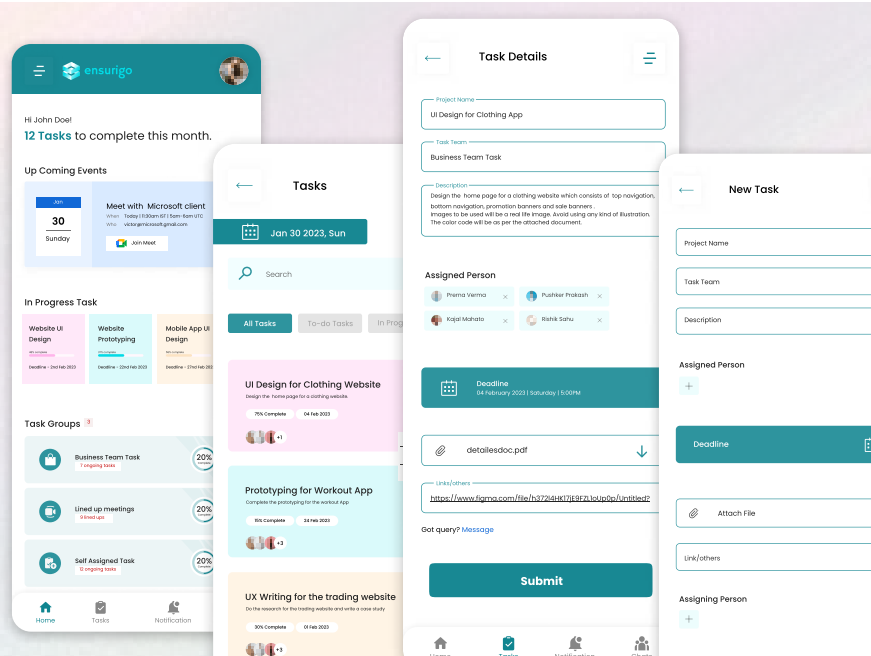

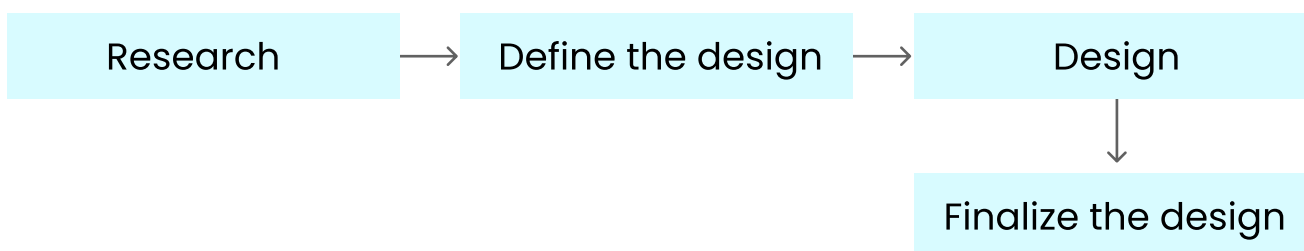
Problem Statement

Ensurigo is a company, looking to design a partner task tracker app used to track the task on which it collaborates with other contractors

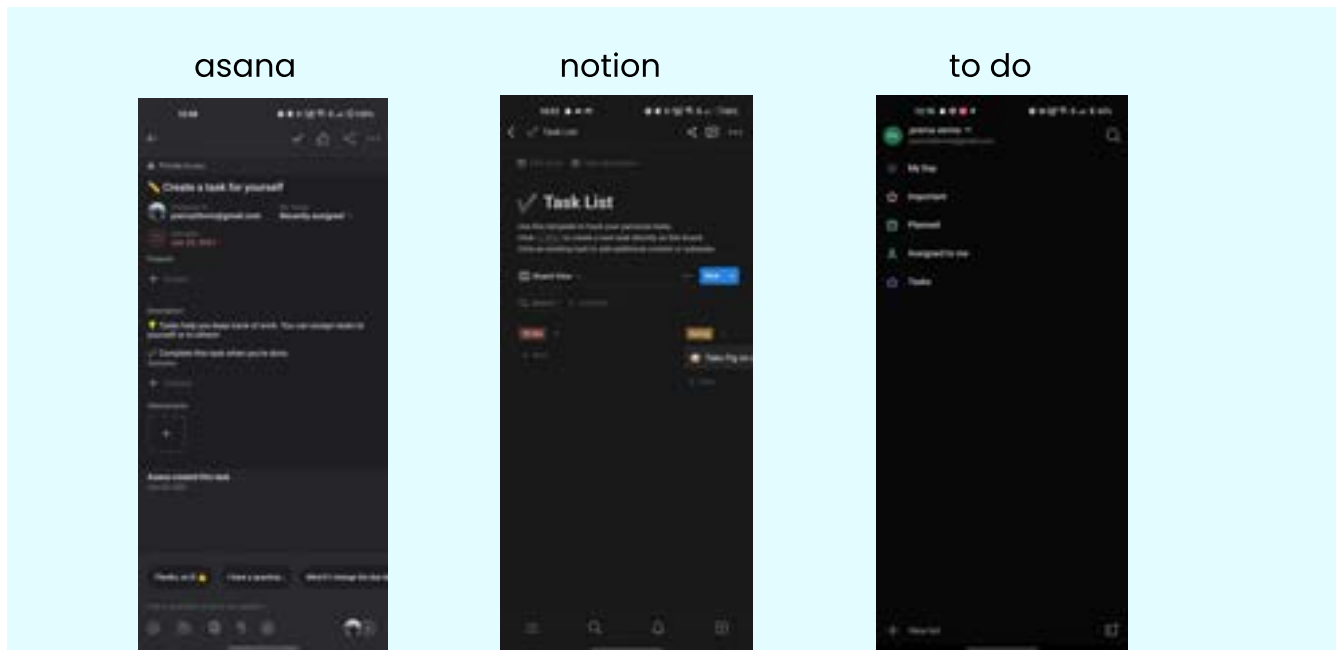
Solution Requirements

After searching about what our competitors (notion, asana, to do, monday.com, ticktick, anydo, tasks etc. and reading about them i concluded-

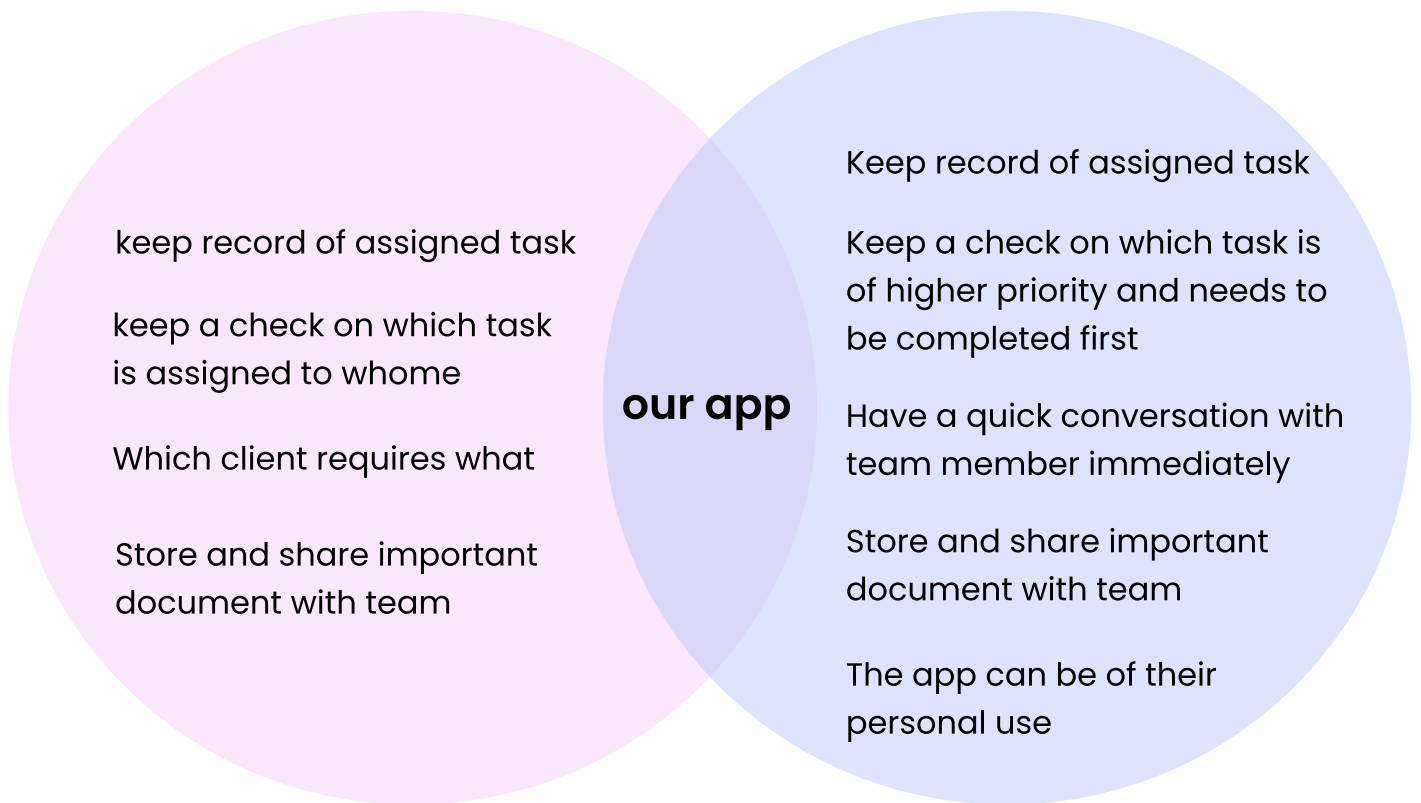
1. Not all the apps had chatting facility.

The main things users add in a task manager are their professional targets, personal targets, store important information etc.

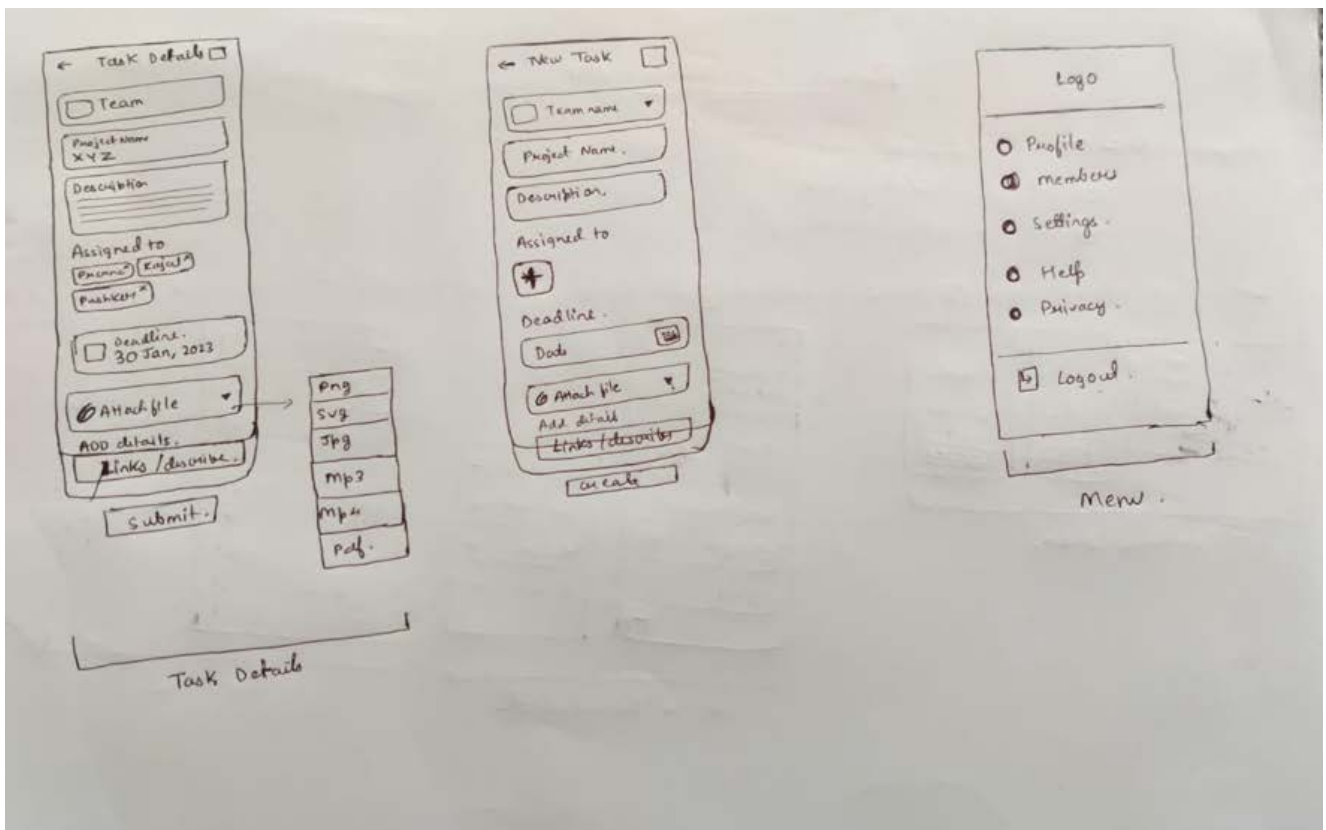
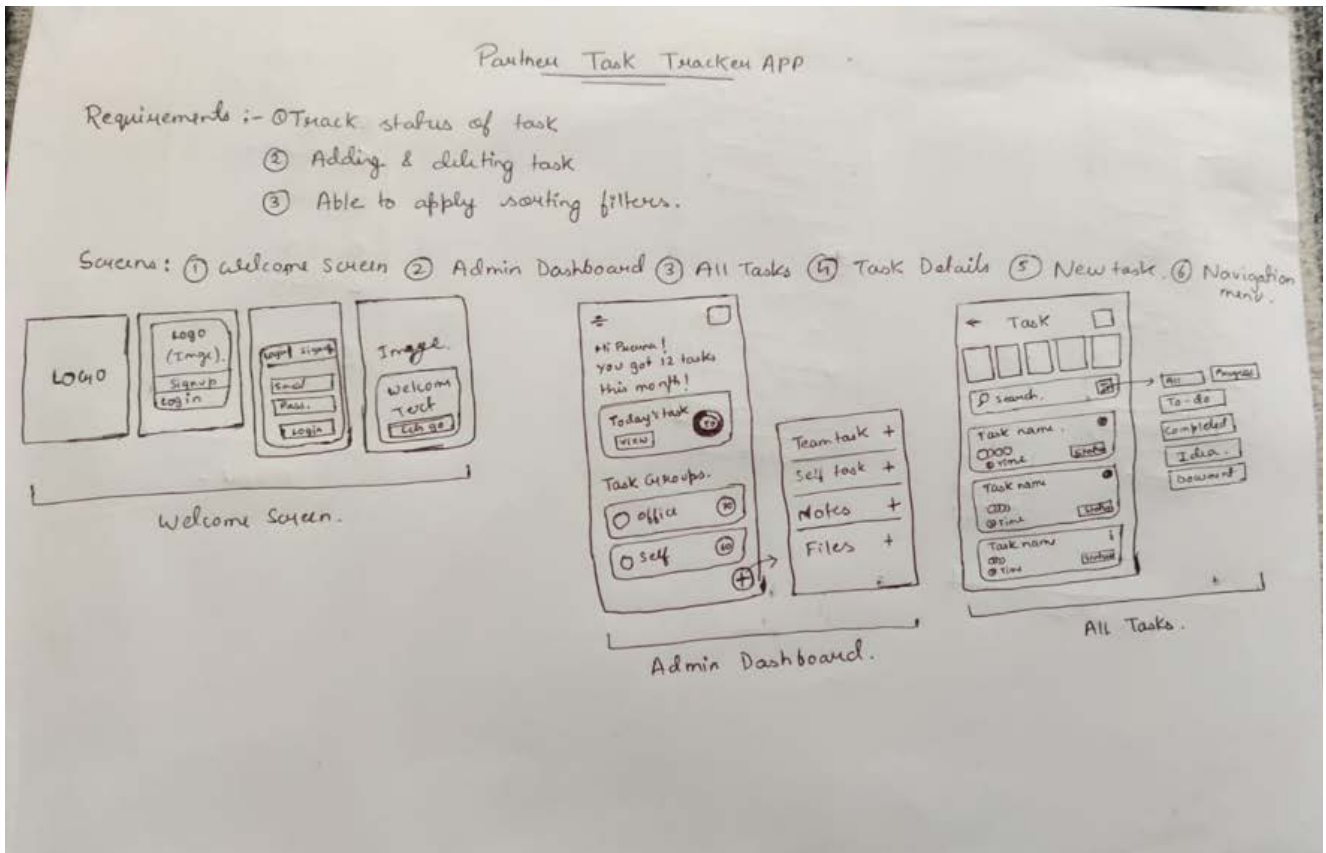
Business need vs User need





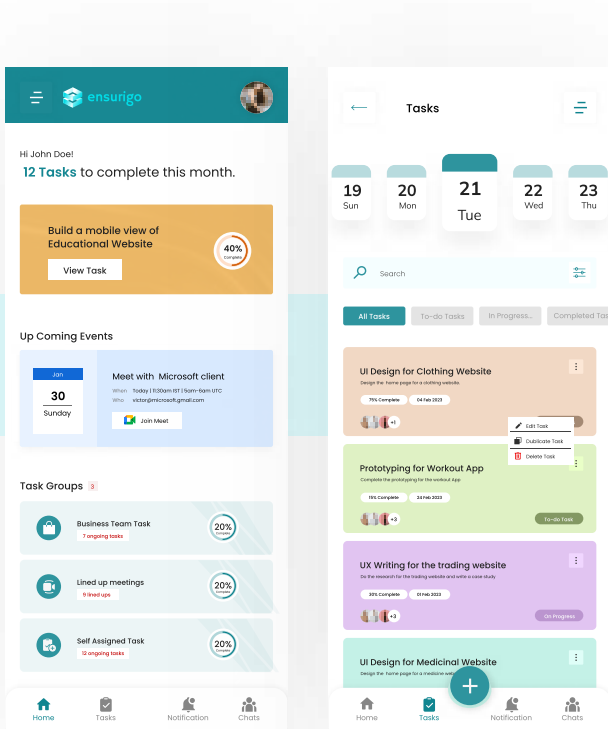

After doing the research, the color I decided to go with was #2E949E as it is the shade of blue which shows trust and was best suited with the provided logo.

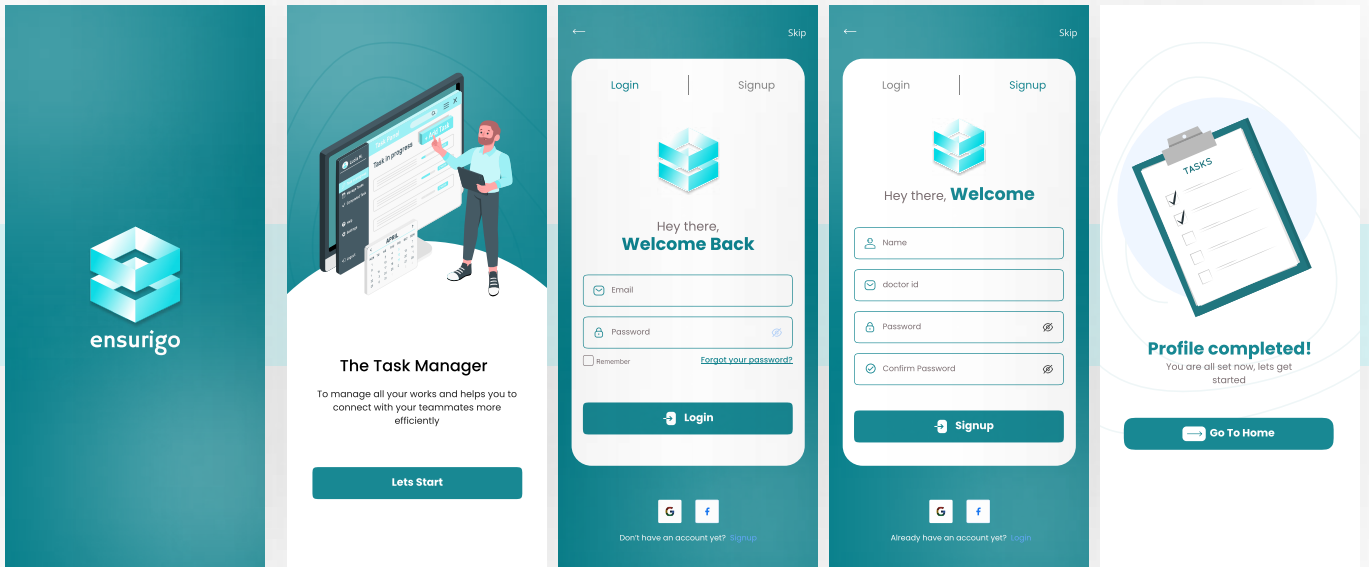
The icons used are of day-to-day life use to make it less complicated for the user to understand.

The placement of CTAs are in the bottom of page in order to make it convenient for the user to interact with the app.

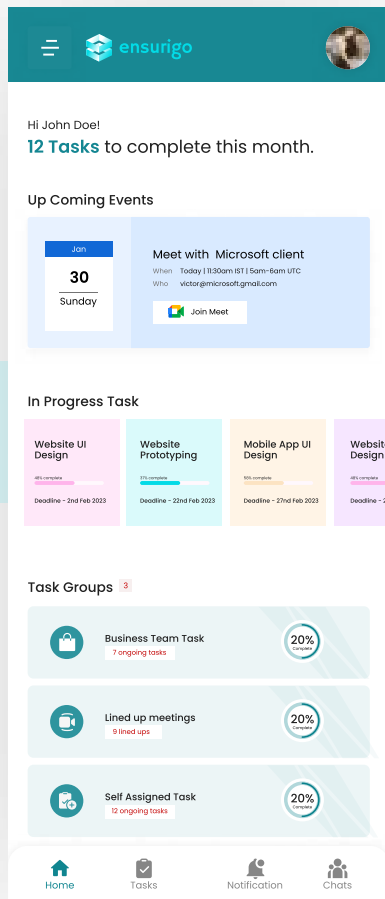
All the instructions are given in the laymen term in order to make user understand it quickly

The placement of menu, profile, notification is kept in place, the user are most familiar with.

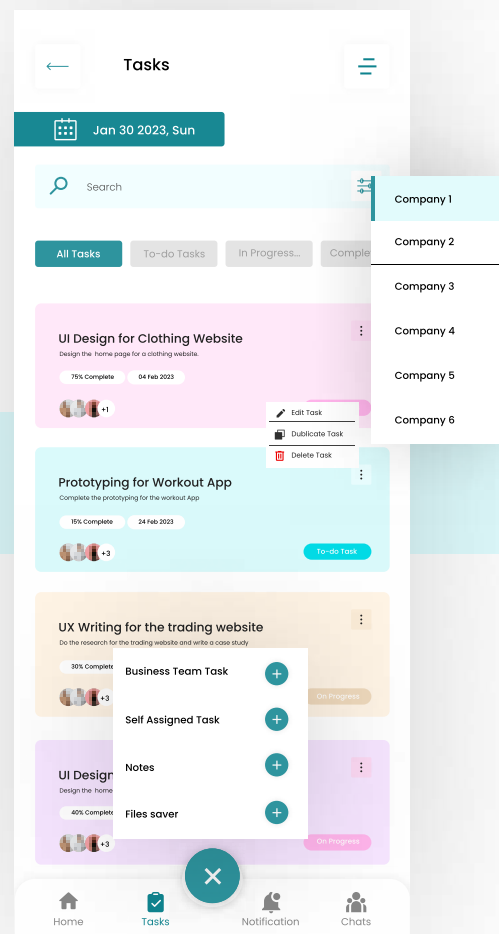
